He call the Hubbartts and went for an interview one evening. He was so impressed with their ranch, kennels and dogs. He saw the little girl that we adopted a month later. She is Chloe Grace Schuessler and comes from Gail and Rays Baron and the late Lana. Baron has an excellent blood line, his father was Ch. Arko Vom Zimmerplatz and his grandfathers were: Hassan Konigsgarten, Sch.111 and Int. Ch. Santo Vom Schwaigger Wappen, Sh.111, Silver Sire.

Gail was so good to keep me updated on Chloe and send pictures before it was time for adoption and flight up to Tulsa. I was so proud the day I met Gail at the airport and brought home my BEAUTIFUL little girl. Chloe is very smart and obedient. She is a very strong and muscular girl. An excellent experience. We kept in close contact with Gail and Ray and kept them updated with email and pictures.

Last Easter, Carl died also of Osteosarcoma at age 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ . It was sudden and we were not able to do any chemo or anything to slow his cancer as we had Lucy. Carl was very special to me and I was just devastated. We could not believe this was happening again. As I am sure you have guessed, our rottts are our children. They are "in the house companions". I called Gail the day after Carl passed and told her. What wonderful support she gave me. She told me then Chloe would need a brother, but I wasn't ready. In July, it was time. Randy, Chloe and I loaded up in the car and drove to Alvarado to have a "family reunion" with the Hubbartts. What a great time, Chloe got to spend time with her Daddy baron and brother Arko. We found a handsome little boy from the Dallas and Zoe litter. He was "cowboy blackie". We picked him out and adopted him on July 29<sup>th</sup>. I flew down to pick him up and what a hit his was in the airport and on the plane. He slept in my arms the whole flight home. Cowboy blackie still wears a black collar but is now named Maxwell Beckham Schuessler. He is strong, tall and handsome. He is 8 months old and will be going to obedience school next month. He looks just

like his father Dallas who comes from the par-excellent bloodline of Chewbacca. Dallas was a son of Chewbacca.

We keep in close contact with Gail and Ray via email and I send a lot of pictures of my growing kids. I love to see pictures of Gails new litters. I fall in love everytime I see one. Gail is always there when I need "parenting" advice or just want to share stories.
